


1.2 SAFETY OVERVIEW – Culture of Safety and Child Safety

- At our core we are a Safety Organisation.
- Creating a culture of safety with our members helps us to keep in front of our minds, that safety of the public and our members is our priority.
- Online SLS Child Safe Awareness Training has been mandated for Club and Branch
 Officers, MPIOs and complaint handlers, Age Managers, Coaches and Officials, Patrol
 Captains, Trainers, Assessors and Facilitators, and is being recommended to cover ALL
 remaining patrolling members this season and to become mandatory next season.
- We also recommend that ALL Watersafety Personnel, that aren't necessarily Patrolling Members, should also undertake this.
- Child Safety pertains to ALL members under 18 years of age, not just Nippers.






5. SLSNSW PRE SEASON INFORMATION

This resource summarises the key activities within junior activities including preliminary skills, competition skills, age awards, Age Manager information, and answers a number of frequently asked questions.



Junior Activity Pre-Season Information



Overview

Please note that there are several key changes in Youth and Junior Development this season:

- The Age Manager now has an annual proficiency, completed by watching the SLSA Age Manager Video via the eLearning Platform. Your Age Manager award will be updated automatically in SurfGuard once you watch the video. See page 5.
- Age Managers who have not been active for five years or more will need to complete the full Age Manager course.
- The Age Manager **no longer requires the third party 'on the beach' assessment paperwork**, yet these practical mentoring sessions will remain, and be coordinated, at a club level. The removal of this administrative step does not remove the need for this practical and ongoing mentoring. See page 5.

- The Age Manager Assistant Award is now only available to members aged 13-15 years. Existing Age Manager Assistants who are 16+ years will not be able to complete their Skills Maintenance until their Award has been upgraded to Age Manager. SLSNSW has undertaken this step and please contact memberservices@surflifesaving.com.au should you wish to check any member record.
- Members can now renew their Working with Children Check (WWCC) online through the NSW Digital ID program, which utilises photo verification technology and a liveness check to confirm a person's presence in front of a mobile phone. It's important to note that this method is only for renewals and not for new WWCC applications.

- This season SLSA is introducing three new sub-membership categories including Silver Salties, Nipper Parent, and Inclusive Program Participant. The SLSNSW Regulations will be updated once implemented. Further information about these sub-categories will be shared by SLSA to clarify how clubs may like to implement at a local level.
- Significant changes have been made to the **Active Kids Program**, with Service NSW announcing a move to a new online platform this year. The availability of Active Kids vouchers is now be means-tested and reduced to \$50 per child. This has impacted Surf Life Saving with **online** voucher redemption unavailable in the 2024/25 season.

- Junior Surf Sport competitors (U/8-U/13) are no longer required to have the relevant Age Award prior to 31 December to compete in Championship events. The Age Awards remain a key educational component of Junior Activities, and this change enables clubs to deliver surf education to members throughout the season. See page 4.
- The Play by the Rules Member Protection Information Officer (MPIO) Course no longer has an expiry date. As such, members taking on the MPIO position are only required to undertake this course once. Ongoing engagement and upskilling will be provided by SLSNSW through the Member Protection Toolkit, the MPIO networking group, and through webinars outlined within the Executive Training Calendar.

- This season the scope of the Member Assistance Program or MAP (formerly known as the Employee Assistance Program or EAP) has been broadened to offer four (4) free confidential counselling sessions to members for Surf Life Saving related concerns (e.g. critical incidents, grievances) without a referral. The MAP is a short-term solution-focused service model.
- An online Sexual Harassment and Misconduct Awareness training module has been added to the SLS eLearning platform and is included in skills maintenance for all active members. Club and branch executive members are also strongly encouraged to complete this training.

Junior Activity Chair Training



Newly appointed Junior Activity Chairs are required to attend and complete the SLSNSW JAC course. Club Nippers is unable to start if training not completed by JAC.

This 2024-2025 course will be held on Thursday 21st September.

Returning JACs must hold the Junior Activity Management Award, and whilst other members of their Junior Activity Team can also hold this award, but they cannot be proxies for the Junior Activity Chair holding this award.

Following the Junior Working Group meeting in February, the JAC Training has been split into two sessions. It is mandatory for new Junior Activity Chairs to attend both sessions, and returning JACs are encouraged to attend Part 2 which will be more of a practical welcome to the season ahead. Please reach out to new JACs to share this training with them and encourage them to register for the sessions also.

Junior Development Resources



Key updates in Junior Activities this season include:

- Clarification on children, dependant on aquatic proficiency, being allowed to move up one age group, and down any number of nipper age groups
- Ability for clubs to enable accredited swim coach sign off on preliminary skills
- Addition of reasonable adjustments clarification to support club delivery

Preliminary Skills and Award Completion



The Junior Preliminary Skills reflect industry standard research in aquatic skills, including greater focus on foundation skills in the water which assist in making rescue ready lifesavers.

The removal of the continuous skill sequence, also results in greater focus on floatation, submersion and propulsion.

In instances where evaluations cannot be completed by a Surf Life Saving member and to increase flexibility for clubs, a qualified and accredited swim coach can complete the evaluation by providing their ASTCA number and details.

Junior Age Awards

It is recommended that nippers who complete 75% of nipper sessions (recorded in nipper attendance sheets or via the app) are eligible for the award and included in the award assessment request. These awards may be processed either directly via SurfGuard or using the SLS Nipper App.

Overview: The SLSNSW Age Managers Course is designed to new Age Managers with the skills, knowledge, and confidence to effectively lead and manager Nippers throughout the season. This session will cover essential topics including the role and responsibilities of an Age Manager, communication strategies, activity planning, safety guidelines, and how to create a positive and engaging environment for Nippers. Members will also learn how to support and collaborate with JACs and other key team members to ensure a consistent and enjoyable experience for all.

Overview: This optional information session is aimed at Junior Activity Chairs and Age Managers, and looks to provide an space for members delivering nippers to reacquaint themselves with best practice in the management and delivery of nippers. The session will cover available resources, compliance and child safety protocols, nipper search and rescue plans, strategies for parent engagement, and the importance of gathering feedback throughout the season. This session will also address several housekeeping items such as sign-on and sign-off procedures, bathroom protocols, and contingency planning to ensure a smooth and safe experience for all participants. This aims to be a fast-paced update and we have made time to answer questions from members at the conclusion of the session. All welcome!

SLSNSW Age Manager Mid-Season Workshop – Age Managers

Overview: This optional workshop is designed to engage and support accredited Age Managers in their role and provide an opportunity for Age Managers continue learning and feel confident in offering an engaging experience to nippers and their families. This session will cover strategies for engaging Nippers and their parents, look at safety and risk management best practices and provide tips for planning the second half of the season. We will hear several clubs case studies and there will be time for networking and best practice sharing between participants.

Age Managers Course Delivery



Age Manager Courses can be delivered at a club or branch level by an Age Manager Mentor.

Age Managers are encouraged to used skilled members to support content delivery – eg using Bronze Medallion holders, coaches, athletes, and members of their education team.

The Age Manager to Child ratio is 1:20 by age group (or stage).

Age Manager Proficiency Video



For the 2024/25 season, SLSA has produced a new Age Manager Video, required to be viewed via the Members Area eLearning portal.

It is important to note that all Age Managers are required to complete the Age Manager Course and Child Safe Awareness Training to be an active Age Manager.

The Nipper 'App' is a platform to be introduced by SLSA, accessible via Members Area. Surfguard also has a new nipper's module for Junior Activity Chair management.

Junior Activity Chairs can:

- Age Managers can access one or multiple age groups at the levels detailed below:




- Manage Nipper Age Groups check in, check out, add notes, view nipper details

Junior Activity Search and Rescue



How would your club manage a missing nipper scenario?

Do you know how to manage a search and rescue operation?

Have you practiced this scenario as a drill?

In all incidents where a search is required, the highest priority must be to focus on a safe and rapid response to commence the search.

Be prepared and have a current and practiced Junior Activity Search and Rescue plan and a search and rescue kit ready on the beach.

SLSA Child Safety Policy – Signage

- SLSNSW have advised they are preparing a set of various posters for use by clubs in different scenarios (including change rooms), with some simple messages. They will be available on Canva which will allow clubs to drop in their own logos, etc.
- They are scheduling these to be available during Child Protection Week in early September.

SLS Sydney Junior Awards of Excellence

- The Branch Youth and Junior Development Committee are proposing further Junior Awards of Excellence to run in parallel to the existing suite of Surf Sports based awards
- Criteria for these will be shared with club in coming months
- The Committee are also considering options for a larger venue to accommodate more people at the Junior AoE Ceremony.
