A warm Sunday evening at Maroubra beach for Maroubra SLSC long service member Roger and his wife celebrating their daughter's birthday. Roger observed 2 people caught in the rip. Realising they were in danger and requiring assistance, Roger grabbed his racing board from the Surf Club and assisted the first person to return to shore. Roger then paddled out to the 2nd man who was being carried further out by the rip.

The 2nd man was exhausted - Roger secured him on the racing board and returned him into shore safely. Friends of the rescued man were very emotional, as he was exhausted and had clearly swallowed a lot of water. The ambulance arrived shortly after conveying the man to hospital.
